November Community Service Opportunities

With the holiday season upon us, we have so much to reflect upon and many things to be thankful for. Cedar Park Dance Company is in its 20th year and we can't think of a better way to celebrate than to give back to the community that has given us so much over the years. Our first community service initiative this month are Blessing Bags. These are bags of items we put together for the homeless community. The overall homeless population on a single night represents 0.2 percent of the U.S. population or 17 per 10,000 people. Our Blessings Bags will include hygiene items, non-perishable food items and socks. As of November 1st, these are the items still needed in order to reach our goal of 50 Blessing Bags.

Items still needed:

- 47 packages of body wipes
- 35 travel size deodorants
- 10 individual tuna packages
- 40 pop top cans of Vienna Sausages
- 16 individual fruit cups
- 30 pairs of Men's socks
- 48 pairs of nail clippers
- 34 tubes of chapstick
- 24 boxes of raisins
- 5 combs
- 3 packages of feminine products

Our second community service project for November will a food drive (non-perishable). Our food drive will take part November 16 - 21 with all donations going to Cedar Park food pantry. Bins will be available in the lobby and outside the front door to collect donations. We will accept any and all non-perishable items you have. Please make sure to check expiration dates.
